



Public Art Program Guidelines

The program's objective is to support professional artists who wish to undertake a public art project, or who have been commissioned to produce a piece of public art by a private or public entity. Applicants can be individuals, groups, organizations or businesses based in Prince Edward County.

Definition Public Art: art in any media that has been planned and executed with the intention of being staged in the physical public domain, usually outside and accessible to all.

Application Deadline : May 30, 2019

For projects taking place before December 31, 2020.

- Results will be announced within four weeks of project submission.
- Successful applicants will be asked to sign a funding agreement, at which time 50% of funds will be disbursed.
- 50% of funding will be with held until the final report is submitted thirty (30) days following the project's end date.

Grant amount(s)

- Applicants are eligible to receive support up to \$1500.

Important

- Total revenues and expenses must balance.
- Projects are assessed by a jury. The following criteria is weighted equally : Artistic Merit, Impact, Viability.

Artist Eligibility

- The artist must have a permanent physical address in Prince Edward County.

- The artist must be an Artist Member of the Prince Edward County Arts Council. Membership must be in place before an application is submitted.
- The artist must be a professional (having graduated from an accredited art program, or having more than 3 years experience working in their field).

Who is not eligible :

- Ad-hoc groups
- Non-professional artists

What this program funds

- Fee to a professional artist.

What this program does not fund

- Fee to under-graduate student or non-professional artist.
- Materials and other costs related to creating/completing/recording or producing art work(s); commissioning/acquiring, documenting, or publishing art work(s).
- Presentation of work in private homes or other venues not open to the public.
- Fundraising and purchasing equipment, e.g. musical instruments, computers, etc.

To apply, please submit the following :

- Application form, including project budget;
- Artist's resumé/bio;
- Artistic examples : e.g. Audiovisual, digital or manuscripts; and
- If applicable, a letter of intent between two parties, including total commission fee for artist and signatures by both the artist and the business/organization.
