The year-round Arts Trail can be a one-stop investment in marketing your business, or an add-on to your own efforts. What we do is deliver value for that investment.

The executive committee is now accepting applications to join the PEC Arts Trail for 2022. If your arts business meets the following membership criteria, we would like to hear from you:

- Must be a resident of Prince Edward County
- Your business is located in PEC; and accessible to visitors
- Sell only authentic / original work
- Show fine art or fine craft that has the artist's name on it, and a biography available for customers
- Sell or display art that is made by the artist, or obtained on consignment from the actual artist
- Be physically open to visitors a minimum of eight (8) months a year. The Arts Trail markets itself to consumers as a year-round organization.
- Post your hours of operation and strictly adhere to them. Some members are open all week, others just a few days a week. You are required to be open for the hours you publish in the Guide and online at artstrail.ca.
- Be a member of the Prince Edward County Arts Council
- Carry a minimum of \$2 million public liability insurance
- Agree to a minimum of 10 hours volunteer time annually to support the Arts Trail.
