



Social Media Content Standards (excerpted from Social Media Policy)

1. Standards for content appearing on County Arts social media posts

County Arts will delete or hide from public view comments/content appearing on our social media posts that contain any of the following, and reserves the right to ban the commenter from County Arts pages:

- Hate speech
- Profanity, obscenity or vulgarity
- Defamation of a person or people
- Name calling and/or personal attacks
- Comments from non-members whose main purpose is to sell a product
- Comments that infringe on copyrights
- Spam comments, such as the same comment posted repeatedly
- Any comments or images that County Arts deems inappropriate and/or that contravene community standards, our values, and/or the content of our Inclusivity, Diversity & Equity Policy (linked on our [Mission & Policies page](#))

2. Content appearing on other social media pages/posts

County Arts may choose to flag (to the appropriate social media platform e.g. Facebook, Instagram) content that meets the criteria mentioned in the previous paragraph and appears on other social media pages, including those of our members and/or on posts that mention or tag County Arts.
